Agreement between the U3As of Burnley, Clitheroe, Longridge and Todmorden

Each of the four U3As wishes to extend the range of provision available to its members through this reciprocal agreement:

- Each of the four U3As would welcome any members of the other at monthly meetings. We would ask members to sign in as visitors and produce their local U3A membership card. There would be no charge for attendance.
- We would welcome members of any of the four U3As at meetings of any special interest groups but would require them to get the agreement of the convenor of the group in advance of the meeting. This is because there could be limited numbers or other problems relating to size of venue, etc.
- If members of the interest group normally pay a fee for the session (eg for room hire, photocopying, etc) the visitor would also be expected to pay this fee.
- We would welcome members of other U3A groups to join us on organised outings and special events if there are surplus places after our own members' requests have been met. The appropriate charge would be made.
- There would be no other financial implications.
- We would expect to supply each other with up to date details of U3A activities through shared newsletters and through our websites.
